- Riders may enter 2 horses in the same age group only. When competing in Rider Class, All-round Pony Club Mount and Pony Club Hack classes must follow the direction of the judge. The 2<sup>nd</sup> horse must be held by an unmounted competent person.
- The mount should be the members normal pony club mount and regularly ridden at Pony Club.
- As with all gear, horse and rider combination must ride at minimum of 2 rally/muster days and be deemed safe by chief instructor.
- The judges and stewards' decision is final.
- A senior member from each club competing to be nominated for Disputes Committee.
- Any dispute must be made in writing, with \$50 fee, within 30 minutes of the event and will be settled by the Disputes Committee
- The committee reserves the right to alter the program in any way that may be deemed necessary.

#### Reservation of Rights

The organiser reserves the right to:-

- (a) to cancel any class or event
- (b) to divide any class
- (c) to alter the advertised time
- (d) to refuse any entry with or without stating the reason
- (e) to transfer competitors between any section of class
- (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors
