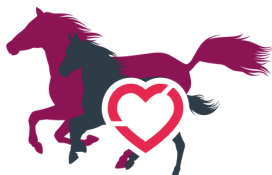

Show rules and Regulations

- **Beginners Ring:** This ring is primarily for riders 17 years and under who are unable to canter due to their lack of rider experience or confidence (not because the horse is green) but are riding independently. Seniors 18 years and over matching the 'Beginner' criteria will be allowed to participate in this ring but will ride HC. A Beginner will not have previously competed above a Walk/Trot level. Winners in this ring are not eligible to compete in any other ring. No supreme champion will be awarded in this ring.
- **Newcomer (green horse class)** is a horse or pony that has not been shown under saddle, (racing excepted), in any discipline at any show or competition prior to the 1st of January 2025. Or who have never competed in a hack event. Horses in the Newcomer classes shall be shown in a snaffle bit.
- A **Maiden** is a horse or pony that has never won first place as a hack at any agricultural show or any other hack show/day.
- A **Novice** is a horse or pony that has never won a champion open at any agricultural show or hack show/day.

- NOVICE, MAIDEN Classes have a performance criterion while Newcomer Classes are for horses in their first calendar year or season (as applicable) of competition. Horses in either Classes should only be asked to perform basic manoeuvres at walk, trot and canter with adequate time for progressive transitions. The purpose of these Classes is to introduce the horse to Competition. A Novice or Newcomer is not expected to be fully educated but should be of good type, athletic in movement and complete a basic workout in a reasonable manner.
- OPEN HACK Classes usually have workouts that allows the Judge to consider the horse's paces, manners and athletic ability. The workout will be designed to show the Judge how the horse can perform. It may include circles, serpentines, lengthening of stride at trot and canter and walk through or trot through changes.
- A Show Hunter is a horse or pony exhibiting "more bone" and is of a heavier build than a Show horse/Hack and is expected to provide a smooth, even ride and be of reliable temperament.
- Riders may enter their mounts in both Hack and Show Hunter classes if they wish, on understanding that the judge's decision will be based on his or her interpretation of the above criteria of a Show Hunter.
- For this event, no gear change will be required
- In the Working Hack Classes, the exhibits will be required to jump two small fences and may be asked to demonstrate a hand gallop - at the judge's discretion.
- A Pleasure Hack is one ridden in a plain snaffle, without spurs, whip or cavesson. Riders may be asked to ride one handed.
- A Consolation Hack is one that has not won first place in any of the preceding classes.
- Stockman's challenge is open to horse or pony any height, to be ridden in western gear and judged on presentation and workout.
- OTT is a thoroughbred or standardbred horse that has raced or had a barrier start at some time in its life but is no longer competing in racing.
- Complaints must be submitted in writing with a PROTEST FEE of \$50.00 to the Chief Steward within 30 minutes of the completion of the class in question. Chief Stewards decision is final.
- Riders are required to be suitably turned out in jodhpurs/breeches with a collard and sleeved shirt
- Plaiting is optional but horses are to be presented in a clean state.
- Pony Club uniforms are not required
- This is an unofficial day.
- The committee reserves the right to adjust the program or running order in any way.

Grounds rules and regulations

- PCQ rules apply to this event. <http://www.pcq.asn.au/>
- PCQ approved helmets, gear and boots must be worn.
- NOTE: Helmets need to comply with the following standards: AS/NZS 3838 (AU) and ARB HS 2012; PAS 015 (UK); ASTM F 1163 (USA); VGI (Europe) EN1384 – Only for helmets with manufacture date up to and including 2015
- This event is open to all riders, however, non-members of PCQ are required to sign a Liability Declaration Form and Waiver prior to competing and an insurance levy is payable.
- No stallions or rigs will be permitted on the grounds for any reason.
- No alcohol, no smoking rules apply
- Bad language, excessive striking of the horse, disrespects to judges or organisers will result in disqualification from the class or the day.
- No dogs are allowed on the grounds.

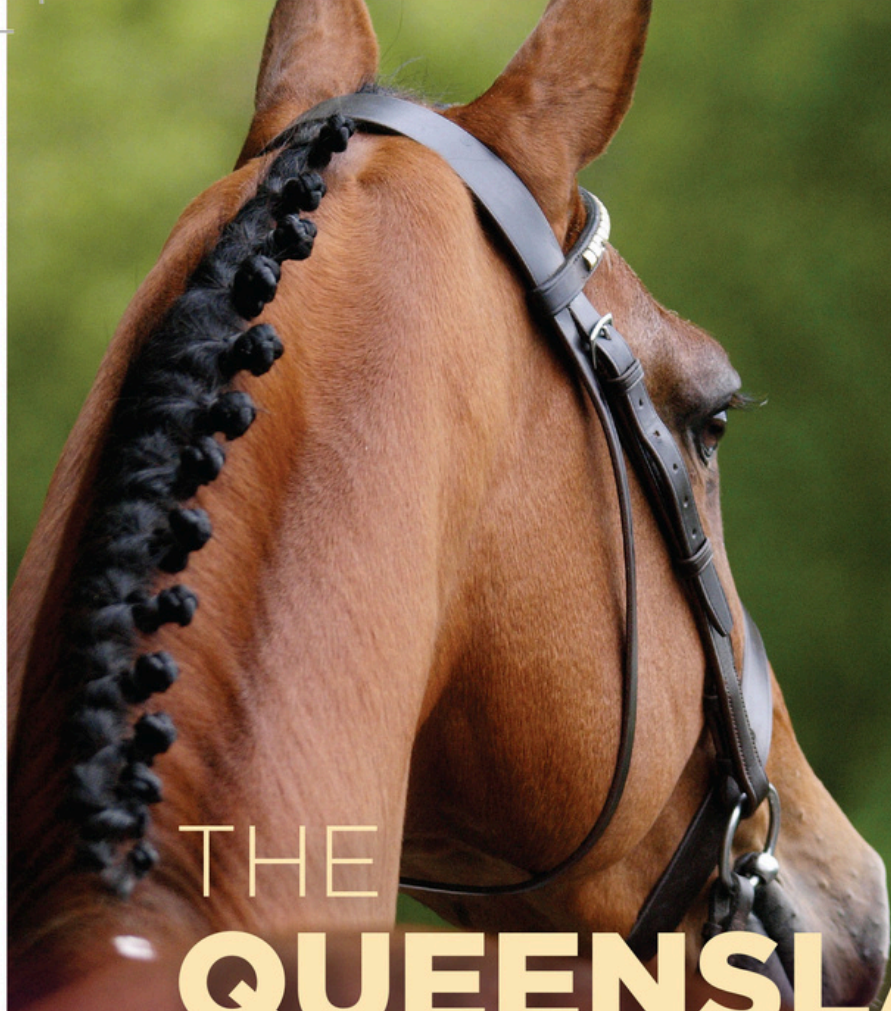
Disclaimer

BEGINNER NOVELTY WORKOUT

1. Trot over 3 trot poles
2. Bend around poles
3. Zig Zag around trot poles
4. Walk your horse over to judge
5. Halt
6. Salute
