- The organising committee reserves the right to combine or split classes according to the number of nominations and to alter/amend the program as necessary.
- One horse, one rider.
- Draw:** Will be emailed to riders and posted on the event Facebook page. The Facebook page will also be updated if weather concerns.
- Back No:** A back number or bridle/saddle pad number must be worn.
- HHD/Waiver:** Horse Health Declarations and insurance waivers must be submitted prior to riding.
- Weather:** Updates will be posted on the event page on the Toorbul Pony Club Facebook page.
- Protests:** To be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted or the incident and be accompanied by a \$50.00 which is only refundable if the protest is upheld.
- Refunds:** Will be made at the discretion of the committee providing the scratching is prior to the commencement of the event and is via email which includes a vet or doctor's certificate. A 10% administration fee may be retained.
- Disclaimer:** Neither the organising committee, nor PCQ accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horse, owner or rider or any other person or property.
- Non-members will be covered by PCA Public Liability Insurance only. There is no personal accident cover provided.
- Code of Conduct:** PCQ and Toorbul Pony Club Code of Conduct will be in effect. Bad language, excessive striking of the horse, abuse or disrespect to any official will result in disqualification.
- Reservation of Rights:** The organising committee reserves the right to: cancel any class or event, combine or divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, alter advertised times, transfer competitors between sections of a class and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.
